# A Sea of Miracles Threatened by Nuclear Power

Biodiversity of Kaminoseki in the Seto Inland Sea, Japan



Chugoku Electric Power Co. Inc. has plans to build two nuclear power plants on the Seto Inland Sea coast in Kaminoseki Town, Yamaguchi Prefecture (2 x ABWR, 1,373 MW). Since 2000, the Ecological Society of Japan has officially protested against this plan because the proposed site is the last biodiversity hotspot for the largest inland sea in East Asia.
